South Asia

The **Kolkata** (kohl-KAH-tah), **India** - The total number of prostitutes in Kolkata is unknown, but some estimates show figures as high as 60,000 women and girls. There are many red-light areas within the city, and these areas are very dark. The largest is called Sonagachi, and it's also the largest red-light district in all of Asia. Sonagachi has several hundred multistory brothels with more than 7,000 workers. The COVID-19 pandemic has greatly impacted these women's lives, as the close living quarters and nature of their jobs makes them a highly vulnerable and exposed group. With less clients, the women struggle to pay rent and provide food for their families. Please remember the thousands of women and girls and families in the red-light districts today. Ask God to provide for their needs. Pray that He will draw them to Himself in lovingkindness, loosen their bonds, and set them free. Ask the Spirit to give the women a desire to be set free. Pray also for the customers who frequent these areas. Pray that the Spirit will give a strong conviction of their sin and that they will repent and believe.
